The ratio of candidates short listed through written test shall be 1:3 i.e. 3 candidates for one advertised post, as far as practicable, will be short listed for viva-voce.

Candidates who qualify in the written examination will be allowed to sit in the typing test on computer followed by an interview. The ratio of candidates short listed through written examination shall be 1:10 i.e. 10 candidates for one advertised post, as far as practicable and will be called for typing test on computer. The ratio of candidates short listed through typing test shall be 1:3 i.e. 3 candidates for one advertised post, as far as practicable and will be short listed for viva-voce.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- I. The number of posts to be filled up is subject to increase or decrease.
- II. Reservation policy in respect of persons with disabilities/Ex-Servicemen will be applied in accordance with prevailing Rules.
- III. Permanent Resident Certificate of Tripura (PRTC) would be required while applying for jobs by direct recruitment as per Notification of GA (P&T) No.F.23(8)-GA(P&T)/2023, dated 07.07.2023
- IV. Reservation: Save as otherwise provided in these Rules Reservation in direct recruitment for various categories of posts

on the District Courts' Ministerial Establishment with respect to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Physically Disabled Persons shall be in accordance with the prevailing policies of the State Government. If no such suitable candidate is available, the posts will be filled up by the candidate other than those of the Scheduled castes, Scheduled Tribes and Physically Disabled Person.

V. Fees once deposited will not be refunded or adjusted for any other recruitment in future. Candidates are to deposit fees by using Credit Card (Visa/Master/Rupay), Net Banking, Debit Card (Visa/Master/Rupay), Wallets & Cash Cards & UPI only. No other mode of payment will be accepted. Bank charge may apply.

Disqualification for appointment— No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

- (a) Unless he is a citizen of India; or
- (b) If he has been dismissed from service by the Government, Central Government, High Court, statutory or Local Authority; or
- (c) If he has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude; or
- (d) If he has more than one spouse living; or
- (e) If he directly or indirectly tries to influence the recruiting authority by any means.

INSTRUCTIONS

I) Online Application:

- a) Candidates have to submit application through Online Application Portal only. The High Court will not entertain any hard copy of application. Before submission of online application, the candidates are to read the instructions carefully in the 'How to Apply' segment of the Online Application Portal.
- b) Online Application Portal will be available on the High Court's Website (https://thc.nic.in) from 02.12.2024 (from 11:00 A.M.) to 02.01.2025 (upto 05:00 P.M.). To apply the candidates have to click on the 'Recruitment' tab in the Home page of the High Court's website.
- c) Candidates should avoid submitting multiple applications. However, due to any unavoidable circumstances, if any candidate submits multiple applications then he/she must ensure that the application with latest Registration Number is complete in all respect.
- d) In case of multiple applications, the one with the latest Registration Number shall only be entertained by the High Court and Fee paid against one

Registration Number shall not be adjusted against any other Registration Number.

- II) Candidates who are eligible for Written Test will be asked for scrutiny of original marks-sheets/certificates/documents before appearing in the Written Test.
- III) The candidates already in Government Services shall apply either through proper channel or attach 'No-Objection Certificate' from his/her employer.
